Dear Infusion Patient,

EPGI is committed to keeping our patients and staff safe. We feel during this unprecedented time it is important to let you know everything we are doing to keep you healthy while you visit our office and infusion room. As we move back towards regaining some normalcy these are the things we have done to prepare the infusion room for your visit:

- We have decreased the infusion room by 1 chair to allow for proper social distancing. There will be a maximum of 3 patients in the infusion room all separated by curtains
- All patients have been screened thoroughly before coming into the building
- We require patients and EPGI staff to wear face coverings (cloth or surgical)
- Only the patient (and required assistance) should come for the infusion appointment. No guests are allowed
- Infusion employees are required to wear masks, goggles, gowns and gloves
- We have added an air filtration system to the infusion room
- Every infusion chair has its own set of equipment that is sanitized between every patient
- Rooms, equipment and common surfaces are sanitized before you receive care

We look forward to seeing you at your next scheduled appointment and will continue to follow recommended guidelines to keep everyone safe. Making sure you and our staff stay healthy is our priority.
